### **What are your opening hours?**

Monday-Friday, 07:15-18:00

To allow our team a well-deserved break and important time with their own families, we will be closed from 6pm on Wednesday 23<sup>rd</sup> December 2026 and reopen on Monday 4<sup>th</sup> January 2027. There will be no fees charged for these dates.

### **What are the fees?**

*Each space will also be subject to a £50 deposit, refundable if terms and conditions are met upon the child leaving Learn and Grow Childcare. Fees are payable in advance by the last day of each month for the following month, i.e. February fees to be paid by end of January. Children who use funded places only are not required to pay a deposit. Fees will be reviewed every April.*

### **Provider Funding for children aged 3+ and eligible 2 year olds**

We are proud to be a provider funded nursery with Dundee City Council. Please contact us for more information re funded places.

### **What is the nursery like?**

The setting has been fully restored and brightly refreshed in 2024 with entirely new resources, indoors and outside. It is a single-storey, predominantly open plan bright, sunny building with excellent spaces both inside and out. There is a full kitchen on site as well as a multi-functional parents/meeting room, staff room, storage rooms and provision for 0-2 room (Yellow Room, 1:3 ratio with maximum of 12), 2-3 room (Blue Room, 1:5 ratio with maximum of 15), 3-5 room (Green Room, 1:8 ratio with a maximum of 32) Each room has a dedicated outdoor space with free flow indoor/outdoor provision exclusive for each age range. There is also separate sleep, changing, and toilet facilities.

### **Who are the staff?**

Learn and Grow is founded and led by Laura Mooney, a GTCS registered teacher with over 17 years of Education experience. Our manager, Lisa Guild, has over 19 years of experience in childcare and will work closely with Laura. Our Room Leads are fully qualified practitioners, two of whom are now working towards their BAs in childhood practice. Each room is also supported by senior Early Years Practitioners. 85% of our team are full qualified practitioners, with the rest being Modern Apprentices who are working towards being fully qualified within the next year.

### **Have you been inspected recently?**

We were inspected in May 2026 by the Care Inspectorate, the Scottish Government regulatory body responsible for ensuring high quality care in Scotland. They graded us Very Good across all areas:

Leadership – 5, Very Good

Children thrive and develop in quality spaces - 5, Very Good

Children play and learn – 5, Very Good

Children are supported to achieve – 5, Very Good#

Key Messages from the report were:

Self-evaluation processes were embedded. Effective quality assurance and monitoring promoted children's safety and supported continuous improvement.

Children and families were actively involved in evaluating the service. Their ideas and suggestions were valued and used to inform positive change.

Children experienced a clean and well-maintained environment. Spaces and resources were planned and adapted in response to children and families needs and preferences.

Children were highly engaged in play and benefitted from the freedom to choose activities that reflected their interests and provided meaningful learning experiences.

Regular tracking of children's learning and clear next steps ensured that children were well supported and making good progress.

Nurturing and responsive relationships supported children to develop confidence and secure attachments. Staff responded warmly and consistently to children's emotional needs, promoting a strong sense of wellbeing.
